Work Matta™ Grit is the most reliable grit flooring surface on the market. With regular cleaning to remove solid particles, oily residue and other deposits, it will provide dependable, effective and ongoing performance as a safety surface.

To prolong the functional life of your Work Matta™ Grit surface these cleaning guidelines are recommended:

- Dry particles can be removed by using an industrial vacuum cleaner, or blowing with compressed air.
- Water-soluble deposits can be removed by spraying with water at high pressure (see notes below). Warm water may be used and will usually give the best results.
- Oil and greasy substances should be removed regularly with soap or detergent (see notes), followed by thorough rinsing with warm water.
- Minimize exposure to sulphur-based oils (EP gear oils and cutting oils) or fluids containing emulsifiers. Any pooling of such liquids should be cleaned off immediately using standard absorption techniques, followed by washing as above.

NOTES: 1. If detergents are used, anionic products only should be applied.

2. Lengthy exposure to non-ionic detergents can degrade PVC and could void applicable warranty/s. 3. Keep water spray pressure to less than 1000psi, with the spray head at a 30-45 degree angle and at least 200mm (8 inches) from the surface. 4. We recommend testing any cleaning methods or cleaning agents you are uncertain about on a small area first. 5.
